





An exclusive 5 day training programme for final years was conducted between 8th september 2016 to 13th septembe 2016 to train students for campus placements.






"PREYAAS - YOUR FIRST STEP"


Orientation Program For II year students

"PREYAAS- New Beginning, Endless Possibilities"


